ELIZABETH NASH FOUNDATION CYSTIC FIBROSIS SUMMER RESEARCH AWARD

Objective

The objective of the Elizabeth Nash Foundation Cystic Fibrosis Summer Research Award is to provide short-term research training opportunities in the specific area of Cystic Fibrosis at the Children's Hospital & Research Center Oakland. The program is open to high school seniors and undergraduate students. The goal is to identify students who have a strong interest in pursuing research in Cystic Fibrosis. The program provides the students with a research training experience to stimulate interest in biomedical and/or clinical research in a friendly and nurturing environment.

To qualify:

- The candidate should have a strong personal interest and commitment to research in cystic fibrosis with a good academic standing
- The applicant should be a High School senior going into College/University or an Undergraduate student
- Students from families or with friends affected by cystic fibrosis are encouraged to apply.

The awardee will:

- Participate in a Cystic Fibrosis research program based on a structured curriculum
- Be paired with a mentor who will guide them through a research project
- Work full-time for 9 weeks (June 10 – August 13, 2010).
- Be provided a stipend of \$2,500. Out of state students may be eligible for a travel/housing stipend.
- Attend weekly seminars and weekly meetings
- Present their research findings at a one-day Research Symposium held at CHORI
