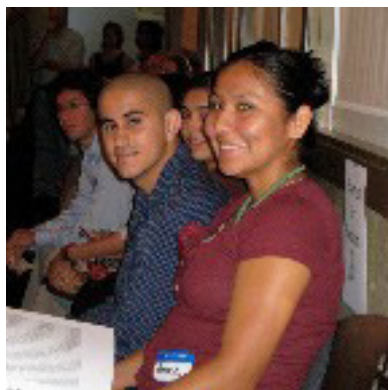


2017 CHORI SUMMER STUDENT RESEARCH PROGRAM
SHORT TERM TRAINING TO INCREASE DIVERSITY IN HEALTH-RELATED RESEARCH
for Undergraduate Students



The objective of the CHORI Summer Student Research Program is to provide short-term training opportunities for undergraduate and health professional students. The goal is to provide research opportunities for individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, racial and ethnic minorities, and others who are underrepresented in this field (e.g. individuals with disabilities). The Program provides the students with a research training experience to stimulate interest in pursuing a career in biomedical, clinical or behavioral research in a friendly and nurturing environment.

To qualify, the student must:

Fulfill the eligibility requirements
(see application on the CHORI web site for details)



Have completed at least one undergraduate year at an accredited university, or those attending community or junior colleges provided they are enrolled in at least 3 courses per academic term.

Be a citizen, non-citizen national, or permanent resident of the United States
(individuals on temporary or student visas are not eligible)

20 funded positions will be available

The awardees will:

Be paired with a mentor who will guide them through a research project

Work full-time for 9 weeks (June 12, 2017 – August 11, 2017)

Participate in a research program based on a structured curriculum

Attend weekly seminars and meetings

Present their research findings at a one-day Research Symposium

Funding: The National Institutes of Health (NIH) provides funding for this program. Students who meet the criteria for the NIH proposal (described on our website) will be eligible to receive a stipend. Please note housing is not provided.
